

#### Ingredients:

- 1 (3 ounce) package lemon gelatin
- · 2 cups boiling water
- 1 (20 ounce) can unsweetened pineapple tidbits, undrained
- 1 (10.5 ounce) can
   mandarin oranges, drained
- I (U OUNCE CAN) FROZEN
   orange juice concentrate,
   partially thawed
- I large, firm banana, sliced

## **Directions:**

- 1. IN a large bowl, dissolve gelatin in boiling water; cool for 10 minutes. Stir in the remaining ingredients.
- 2. Spoon into foil cups. Freeze until firm.
- 3. Remove from freezer 30 minutes before serving.
