4-H Trailblazers Horse Club

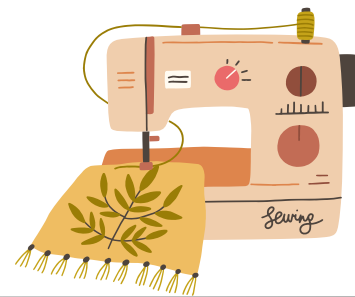

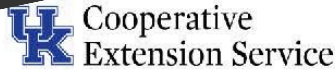


Support Kentucky Ag Tag Program!
